## Important School Policies

**School Hours:** Regular school hours will be Monday through Friday. 7:55am- 3:00 pm for elementary students and 8:20am – 3:00pm for preschool and PreK students.

**Lunch:** Lunch will be provided for all students (PreK and under). Students may choose to bring a lunch. Kindergarten and above may purchase lunch for \$4 in the office.

# Curriculum

## **Nursery-Preschool 3s**

Our youngest learners have the privilege to grow with the early brain research developed Frog Street Curriculum from 6 weeks to three years old. Frog Street highlights experience-based learning where our teachers facilitate and guide children in repeated explorations to support and reinforce brain wiring. It integrates Dr. Becky Bailey's "Conscious Discipline" strategies as well to support rich classroom communities and healthy child social-emotional development.

## **PreK 3s & 4s**

Students in these classes are beginning to learn about the nuances of a school setting while also receiving an introduction to instruction in the main core subject areas. The McGraw-Hill "World of Wonders" curriculum guides instruction in phonics and pre-reading skills, mathematics, science, and social studies concepts, as well as social-emotional skills, basic music and movement, and outdoor play opportunities.

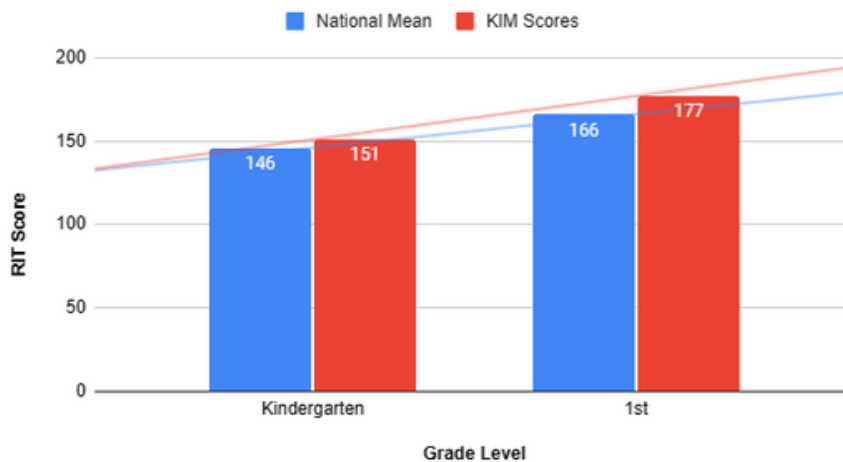


# Curriculum

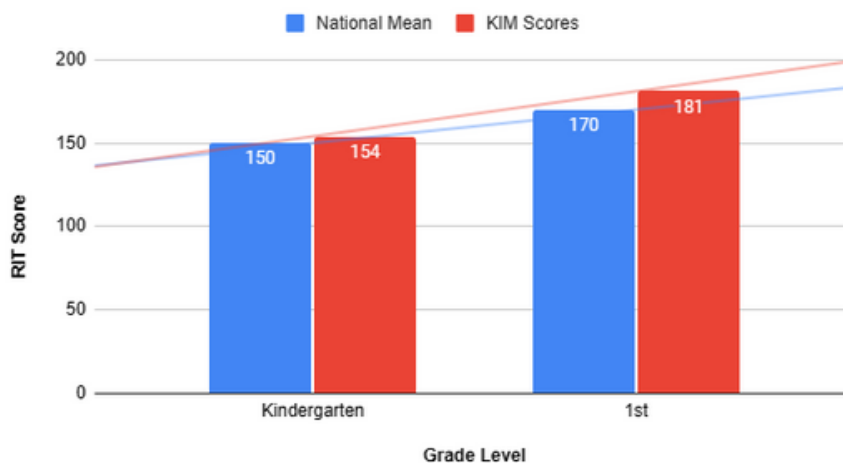
## Elementary

Our curriculum meets state and national standards in each of the core subject areas. Students are monitored for growth throughout the year using the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment in Math and Reading, and their pre-reading and reading skills are measured three times a year using the Texas Primary Reading Inventory (TPRI) assessment. The curriculums we use are: McGraw-Hill's "Reading Wonders," Great Mind's "Eureka Math Squared," and Pearson/Savvas Education's "MyWorld Interactive" for Social Studies and "Elevate Science."
